



PPVS Neonatal Wellness Plan 2018

Pre-Foaling Vaccination Visit

- ✓ 10 month pregnancy vaccinations for the mare
 - Tetanus-West Nile Virus-EEE-WEE
 - Rabies
 - Flu-Rhino

Post-Foaling Visit (8-12 hours after foaling)

- ✓ Physical exam of the mare and extensive exam of the foal
- ✓ IgG test for the foal
- ✓ Deworm the mare with Eqvalan (Ivermectin)

Foal Deworming Schedule

Since foals are more sensitive to parasites than adult horses, they need to be treated differently.

- ✓ 2 months of age: Deworm with Anthelcide
- ✓ 4 months of age: Deworm with Strongid P
- ✓ 6 months of age: Deworm with Eqvalan
- ✓ 7 months of age: Fecal egg count
- ✓ 9 months of age: Fecal egg count

Foal Vaccination Schedule

- ✓ 5-6 months of age
 - Tetanus-West Nile Virus-EEE-WEE
 - Flu-Rhino
- ✓ 4-6 weeks after the initial vaccinations
 - Tetanus-West Nile Virus-EEE-WEE
 - Flu-Rhino
 - Rabies

Dewormers

The dewormer for the mare and the 3 dewormers and 2 fecal egg counts for the foal are included in the price. Additional dewormers dispensed based on fecal egg count results are not included.

Cost

By enrolling in the Neonatal Wellness Plan you save more than 10% on the items included in the package! The call fees are not included in the plan. In the event of the sale or death of the horse, pro-rated refunds will be given. You also have the option to switch the plan to a new horse, or to sell the plan to the new owner of the horse, provided the horse is staying within the practice area. Additional veterinary visits throughout the year will be charged at the usual rate.
